SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY:

In order to apply, you must have a High School Diploma or equivalent, and qualify as a member of one of the three groups: Active, Reserve, or prior-service U.S. Marine.

If active/reserve, submit a written statement of service on official letterhead and signed by the Adjutant, Personnel Officer, XO, or CO of the unit or organization.

If former Marine, submit a copy of your Form DD214 (must show the “character of service”).

2. PERSONAL DATA:

If any of your submitted materials contain your SSN, you are encouraged to back out all but the last four of its digits, as an identity theft protection measure. You will only be required to submit your full SSN prior to receiving of a monetary award.

3. CONTEMPORARY ISSUES ESSAY:

The essays, upon submission, will become property of the Marine Corps Mustang Foundation, and may be reproduced, in part or its entirety, at the discretion of the Marine Corps Mustang Foundation, with full credit always given to the author.

4. APPLICATION AND ALL ENCLOSURES:

The application in its entirety, to include all attachments and enclosures, will not be returned and will become the property of the Marine Corps Mustang Foundation upon submission.

5. AWARD RECEIPT ELIGIBILITY:

In order to obtain and maintain a grant, for the given academic year, the recipient must be in attendance at an accredited, baccalaureate degree granting, college or university, maintaining a 2.0 grade point average, and remain in good standing on track to graduation and commission. The grants are not renewable, but the recipients can apply for subsequent annual awards, provided that they continue to meet the eligibility requirements.

Upon selection of the recipients, and prior to the distribution of the award, the recipients, conditioned to the acceptance of the award, will provide to the Scholarship Committee sufficient evidence of projected attendance at an accredited, baccalaureate degree granting, college or university, for the academic year of the grant, along with the published tuition and fees costs. At the completion of the given academic year, the recipients are to provide to the Scholarship Committee grade transcripts for the given academic year along with sufficient evidence that the grant was applied towards qualified education expenses. If the end-of-year obligations are not met, the grant will be revoked and the given recipient will be liable for payback of the grant, as well as disqualified from any future grants.

6. PRIVACY POLICY:

Marine Corps Mustang Foundation will protect all of the information it receives and will never share or distribute any of the personal data submitted with the exception of the names and likeliness of the award recipients that may be published annually on the website, the annual report, or any additional reports as required by law and news releases relating to the receipt of the award.
